

## Handicap Committee Report

There had been discussions and controversy last year over weekly tournament scores being posted as (H) home scores instead of (T) tournament. Jean Young and myself attended a GHIN Handicap seminar last fall. MSGA followed up with USGA to send an explanation on why weekly scores are posted as (H). A short synopsis of the explanation is below:

(T) Scores represent championship play. Such as MWA, Senior Championship or a local Club Championship.

(H) Scores are any weekly tournaments held by a club or association.

WMSGGA is considered a club, as we hold weekly tournaments as an association. All of WMSGGA regular weekly tournaments are considered (H) because they fall under the umbrella of our association.

(A) Away scores would be scores you post online after playing a round at a course other than your local club.

A reminder to all of you who play golf in the south during the winter months. It is your responsibility to post all rounds that you play. If you belong to a club out of state you should be using the same GHIN number as you use in Maine. If you do not belong to an out of state club or association it is your responsibility to post every score to your GHIN during the winter.
