

**Report of the Administrative Assistant
Annual Meeting
Tuesday, September 24, 2013
Penobscot Valley Country Club**

As the 2013 golf season winds down I would like to report the status of this organization. Like everything else these days business has been a little off.

This year there are 287 individual members (down from 299 last year) and there were 7 junior members (down from 8). The club memberships are at 72 (down from 75).

Many factors effect tournament participation. Things like weather, gas prices, and even age of the members (speaking for myself, of course!) Play for this year was 1,540 (down from 1,703) but junior play was a little better at 19 (up from 18).

It seems like we are trying to interest more ladies to join us though, since we had 26 guests this year (up from 9). So maybe this will increase our numbers next season!!

Fewer players translate to fewer dollars to be dispersed in vouchers. This season we have \$7,950 (down from \$8,515). The points for this year totaled 1079 (down from 1250). This season we put \$3,550 into skins (down from \$3,920).
