About the WMSGA

The Women's Maine State Golf Association dedicates itself to promoting interest among women in the game of golf and makes a solid commitment to support Maine's junior girls who enjoy the sport. The WMSGA supports the MSGA Scholarship Fund and the Maine Golf Hall of Fame.

COURSE RATING REQUIREMENTS

All courses that are members of WMSGA must be rated. A course must be at least 3,000 yards in length (for 18 holes) in order to be rated.

CLUB REPRESENTATIVE to the WMSGA

Each member club will appoint a club representative to WMSGA. Ideally, the rep should be a club member that's also a member of WMSGA. If a club has only one WMSGA member, she will act as representative. If that's not possible, a club owner or manager may act as club representative.

ELIGIBLE CLUB MEMBERS

All women and junior girls who are members of your club and who have established USGA handicap indexes may apply for individual membership and play in our weekly tournaments. They may also play in special tournaments if they meet the particular eligibility requirements of those tournaments.

TOURNAMENT OBLIGATIONS OF MEMBER CLUBS

Each member club will host a tournament once each season unless not on the rotation.

- The host course will work in conjunction with the WMSGA tournament chairwoman and administrative assistant to organize and conduct the tournament.
- All 18-hole courses of championship caliber will be expected, but not obligated, to host the Maine Women's Amateur (MWA), our state championship, on a rotational basis. The course holding the MWA will earn the privilege of hosting the Metropolitan within two years of hosting the championship.
- Host courses will charge no more than one-half cart fee per person even though it may not always be possible to place two people in every cart. If the host club incurs an expense from bringing in extra carts, WMSGA will guarantee payment for carts cancelled after Sunday's 6 pm deadline and for carts reserved for players who do not show up.

TOURNAMENT FYI

Additional WMSGA tournament information you may want to know...

- The WMSGA tournament schedule is determined by the tournament committee with final approval from the WMSGA executive board.
- Tournament setup and scoring is done by WMSGA.
- WMSGA weekly tournament fees: green fee \$17/entry fee \$10/total \$27.
- Winners of regular weekly tournaments will receive vouchers that may be redeemed only at WMSGA member clubs.
- Winners in the MWA must redeem winnings at the host club.

MEMBERSHIP DUES

Annual dues for membership in the WMSGA: club \$50/individual \$35.
